I also want to take this lone and highly favored opportunity to thank Dr. Goodheer of the International Christian University for the tireless efforts he has made in ensuring that these students clad in graduation qualify with a quality paper backed by their total input effort.

It is a great pleasure to be with you today at your first graduation ceremony after the validation of the college programs. After all, it is a day of joy for everyone: You graduates have no more exams or classes to endure. And I might say, the

faculty no longer has you to endure; you have fame and fortune ahead of you; your families and spouses and friends can look forward to seeing more of you perform great things for them and for your country

When he became the president, he became quite discouraged when his attempts to promote economic recovery during the Great Depression seemed to make little headway. However the President expressed his discouragement noting that he was particularly disturbed that, in spite of all of his efforts, his critics were becoming ever more vocal and belligerent. Nevertheless his aide comforted him; Don't expect to see calves running in the field the day after you put the bull to the cows. But the President replied; "but I would at least expect to see some contented cows.

This is how bridge builders get lost in the pursuit for excellence. Anyone who has worked in public service knows that the fight never seems easy while it is being waged. You cannot expect that your efforts will meet with immediate success. But the ever-present understanding that you are a part of something bigger than yourself, and that your efforts are paving the way for those who will follow, makes a life of public service worth the bumps along the way. A single generation of public servants cannot bridge all the gaps of inequality and injustice nor span the chasms of your country. But if we focus our energies on sharing ideas, finding solutions and using what is right with Kenya to remedy what is wrong with it, we can make a difference. Your degree obtained today should be the tool to measure these mishaps. Your nation needs bridges, and bridges are built by those who look to the future and dedicate themselves to helping others. I don't know what the future holds, but I know who holds the future: It is you. Commit yourselves today, as you embark on your new life as a PaulMark graduate, to being a bridge builder. We need you, and those who cross the bridges you build will thank you. Congratulations!!

IU's undergraduate programs are based on the American educational system, requiring a core of General Education courses to strengthen students' life skills (e.g. Philosophy, Sociology, Psychology, Literature, and History), followed by a strong core of Major courses in Business Administration or Diplomatic Studies, and then elective courses to strengthen the students' academic program. On the Master's level, only courses in Business or Diplomatic Studies are required.

IU has over 25 years of experience in transforming the lives of students from over 100 different countries and opening further educational and career opportunities for them. In addition, IU also provides generous tuition-waiver scholarships for needy students. 





